## TEAM-BUILDING & FACILITATION

Students learn how to start and facilitate challenging discussions to build positive team dynamics, and practice these skills in real-life scenarios to interrupt bullying.

## SELF-AWARENESS & CONFIDENCE

Participants discover a greater awareness of their own identity and how they can leverage that to create positive change. They gain confidence around intervening as a leader, especially when it is not popular to do so, and learn to empower others to do the same.

## S.M.A.R.T. GOALS SETTING

Students work in small groups to create S.M.A.R.T. (Specific Measurable Achievable Relevant and Time-bound) goals across four levels (individual, interpersonal, classroom and school). These plans, along with the one created by educators are then shared with the entire group, allowing all to leave with a host of actionable items.
